b. Shutdown the PC, enter:

sudo shutdown -h now

At the telescope

- 1. Ensure the SHOC PC is turned OFF. Check that the blue LED, masked with black tape on the front-bottom of the PC, is OFF.
- 2. Turn OFF power to the crate, then unplug the mains cable (kettle plug) from the inlet socket at the back.
- 3. On the Andor camera, disconnect the following cables:
 - a. The DC power
 - b. The Video
 - c. The GPS external trigger
- 4. On the crate, disconnect the following cables:
 - a. Network
 - b. GPS Antenna BNC
 - c. Filter controller USB
- 5. On the filter wheel, disconnect the two cables at the DSUB connector interface.
