## **Warm Room**

 Ensure that TCS is locked out by turning the TCS Lockout switch on the mimic panel (refer to figure 1) to ON state. TCS Control indicator will flash as a warning that the TCS is locked out.

- 2. Close program and shutdown PC.
- 3. Store monitor, keyboard & mouse in PLC Room OR: Push monitor, K/B and mouse to the back of the desk and place SpUpNIC monitors etc in front.

## **Observing Floor**

- 1. If the Acquisition box is to be removed:
  - a. Ensure that the telescope is switched off
  - b. Disconnect the following:
    - i. XYslides cabling
    - ii. Acquisition camera USB cable
    - iii. Acquisition box mains cable
    - iv. TCS acquisition box control cable (D15 flat cable)
    - v. Instrument air hose
- 2. Ensure that:
  - · Dark Slides are closed
  - Eye Pieces are in beam
  - PMT's power supplies (HT supplies) are OFF
- 3. Switch off the two cold box power supplies.
- 4. Disconnect mains cable from Telescope UPS supply strip (All electronics are powered via a mains strip mounted on the instrument).
- 5. Remove Instrument
- 6. Park Instrument in corner on Observing floor and plug in the mains cable again.
- 7. Switch on both cold box power supplies and check they are running OK
- 8. Double check that HT PSU's are switched OFF

## In Warm room

**NB!!!** Ensure that **TCS Lockout** switch on the mimic panel is set to **OFF** state. TCS Control indicator will stop flashing.
